##### **Rationale**

Owing to the growth of the Microfinance Sector in Zimbabwe and beyond, ZEGU endeavours to address the lack of comprehensive programmes to build the capacity of those in this important sector. After consulting stakeholders in this sector, ZEGU is offering a Diploma in Microfinance Management to equip employees and prospective employees for the Microfinance Industry with appropriate skills.

##### **Who should apply?**

The Diploma in Microfinance Management provides a broad based, practical overview of the key ideas, techniques and skills required by microfinance practitioners. **The programme targets two sets of candidates; microfinance practitioners and school leavers.**

##### **Why study at ZEGU?**

The Diploma is offered on flexi-study terms and allows students to fit their studies to their work and/or social commitments. Enrolment is open throughout the year and the programme is run over two semesters on block release, or evening classes as well as weekend classes basis. Thus, it provides opportunities to accelerate career growth through:

- ❖ Flexible study time (both block and parallel)
- ❖ Teaching staff composed of accomplished academics and MFI practitioners
- ❖ MFIs can also request for in-house training, where a large group is seconded for training, for part certification.
- ❖ Covers a broad spectrum of pertinent contemporary courses in the microfinance terrain.

**The diploma is offered from the main campus in Bindura and the Harare Teaching and Learning Centre located in Belvedere (behind the City Sports Centre).**

### **For current MFI Practitioners**

- ❖ 5 'O' level passes including English and Mathematics
- ❖ Plus, relevant working experience.

### **For High school leavers**

- ❖ 5 'O' level passes including English and Mathematics
- ❖ Any 2 A' Level passes, with preference for commercially related subjects.

## **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Applications may be received any time of the year but applications for the **March to June 2018 semester closes as follows:**

- ❖ 9<sup>th</sup> February 2018 (for block release applicants), lectures resuming on 12 February 2018
- ❖ 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2018 for weekend classes, with lectures resuming on 10 March 2018.
